

GRANGE PARK NEIGHBOURHOOD DEVELOPMENT PLAN SURVEY

Grange Park Parish Council (GPPC) have started a project to produce a Neighbourhood Development Plan (NDP) for our parish. This survey is to gain your input into what the content of the plan should be.

What is a Neighbourhood Development Plan (NDP)?

A Neighbourhood Development Plan is a community-led initiative that allows local residents to have a direct influence on the future development of their area. It can be a comprehensive document addressing various aspects of community life, such as housing needs, building design standards, traffic management, community facilities, the environment, and more. Alternatively, it can be a focused plan that targets a specific issue.

The plan must be created based on input from the community, typically gathered through a survey or questionnaire. It then needs to be approved by the local planning authority, which ensures it aligns with their planning policies. Once the draft plan receives approval from the local authority, it goes to a local referendum for a vote by the community. If accepted in the referendum, it becomes part of local government policy and must be considered when making decisions on planning applications.

Grange Park Neighbourhood Development Plan (GPNDP / Survey)

Grange Park is a sustainable village built over the last 20 plus years. The parish consists of a mix of residential and commercial buildings, community assets (e.g. community centre and Foxfield Sports Pavilion), open green spaces, woodlands and agricultural farmland.

GPPC have formed a Neighbourhood Development Plan Steering Group to develop a GPNDP on behalf of the parish. The Steering Group needs the local community to have their say through this, GPNDP Survey.


